Match Directors and representatives from Green Valley Rifle & Pistol Club, Pioneer Gun Club and the Southwest Louisiana Rifle & Pistol Club are proud to announce the 2019 Action Pistol Triple Cup Challenge (APTCC). The goal is to increase participation at the club and regional level in NRA Action Shooting. The series features 3 rounds of competition starting in April with the Crawfish Cup in Louisiana. The second round will be held right before the NRA Bianchi Cup in Bates City, MO for the Flagler Cup. The final round will be hosted by Green Valley Rifle & Pistol Club in Hallsville, MO for the 2019 Cameron Cup.

**What do you need to do?** Mark your calendars, register and compete in all 3 regional competitions. There is no entry fee for the APTCC, but competitors must compete in all 3 rounds in order to be eligible for trophies and prizes. The current awards schedule is listed below:

If you choose to compete in more than 1 division at the regional events, you must declare your intended division for the Triple Cup Challenge by Round 2. If you choose to shoot a different division in each round, for example Open at the Crawfish Cup and Production at Flagler and Cameron, you may still enter the Triple Cup but you will automatically be placed in the Open Division. In the event of a tie, competitors will compete in a shoot-off at the Cameron Cup.

Each participant will receive a certificate with their aggregate score, division and classification. Details for overall finish, classification and special category rankings will also be included in the results. Category and classification champions will be acknowledged in an awards bulletin.
